

Alt Erlaa Residential Park

Architectural Tour

Duration: 2 hours | Languages: English or German

Why are the apartment blocks in Vienna's Alt Erlaa district still fascinating after nearly 50 years? The residential park, home to some 10.000 people, was designed by Arch. Harry Glück and built in two phases in 1976 and 1985. It evolved from a fiercely criticised project to a highly praised architectural hit. Blamed for being a "housing machine for an anonymous mass" the residential park was steadfastly defended by its residents.

Exceptional living comfort, green terraces, sauna and roof top swimming pool, as well as a shopping park and an active neighborly community with the highest possible privacy are the key factors, which result in a level of residents' satisfaction of more than 90%.

The guided tour comprises:

- Tour through the entire area and community facilites
- Visit of the rooftop terrace
- Viewing of an apartment (depending on availability)
